



# **SPSS<sup>®</sup> Statistics for Mac OS<sup>®</sup> Abbreviated Installation Instructions (Site License)**

The following instructions are for installing SPSS using a site license.

During installation, you will be prompted for the following information. Except for the serial number, all information is required. This information will be provided when you purchase a site license from the UI Bookstore. Contact ITS Help Desk Support (<http://helpdesk.its.uiowa.edu/>) if you do not have the required information.

## **System Requirements for SPSS Statistics**

The minimum hardware and software requirements for SPSS Statistics are as follows:

### **Operating System**

- Mac OS<sup>®</sup> X 10.4 or higher.

### **Configuration**

- Intel processor.
- 512 megabytes (MB) of RAM or more. At least 1 gigabyte (GB) is recommended.
- 825 megabytes (MB) of available hard-disk space. Installing help for all languages requires 2.3 gigabytes (GB).
- CD-ROM drive.
- Super VGA (800x600) or a higher resolution monitor.
- For connecting with SPSS Statistics Server, a network adapter running the TCP/IP network protocol is required.

### **Software**

- Web browser: Safari 1.3.1 or higher, Firefox 1.5 or higher, or Netscape 7.2 or higher.
- Java Standard Edition 5.0 (J2SE 5.0).

## ***Installing SPSS Statistics***

When you purchase a site license, a network location from which to download and install SPSS Statistics will be provided.

The procedure for installing SPSS Statistics is contained in this document. Check with ITS-Help Desk Support (<http://helpdesk.its.uiowa.edu/>) if you experience any difficulty following this procedure. *Note:* To install SPSS, you must be logged on to your computer with administrator privileges. When you initiate the install process, you will be asked to reenter your administrator password before SPSS will proceed.

## ***Upgrading from a Previous Release***

You do not need to uninstall an old version of SPSS before installing the new version. If you want to keep both versions, be sure to install the new version in a separate directory.

## ***Installing from a Downloaded File***

- Download the file from the location specified on the site license agreement.
- Double-click *SPSS Statistics Installer*, and then follow the instructions that appear on the screen. See [Notes Specific to UI Installation](#) below for any special instructions.
- SPSS Statistics will be installed in the following (default) location:  
    /Applications/SPSSInc/Statistics17

## ***Notes Specific to UI Installation***

This section contains special instructions for this installation.

**Serial number and Authorization Code:** When you purchased your license from the UI Bookstore you should have been provided a serial number and an authorization code. Contact ITS Help Desk Support (<http://helpdesk.its.uiowa.edu/>) if you did not receive the serial number and authorization code.

**Help language:** SPSS Statistics provides the ability to change the user interface language. If you want the help language to always match the user interface, select *Install Help in all languages*. Installing help for all languages significantly increases disk space requirements.

*Note:* Previous versions of SPSS required separate authorization codes for SPSS Base, Regression, and **Advanced Models**. **SPSS Statistics no longer requires a separate code for each module.**

## ***Using the License Authorization Wizard***

- ▶ If you did not launch the License Authorization Wizard during installation or canceled the License Authorization Wizard before obtaining a license, you can launch it at any time by clicking the License Authorization Wizard icon in the SPSS Statistics application folder.
- ▶ The License Wizard will automatically drop into a License Status window which reports the SPSS products currently licensed to operate on your computer. Select *Next*.

- ▶ The Wizard will proceed to the Choose Licensing Method window. Choose License my product now. Select Next.
- ▶ Enter one or more authorization codes and select Next. You can authorize more than one SPSS product in this step by selecting Enter additional codes. Each authorization code must be entered in the same format as that provided by the UI Bookstore (upper/lower case rules apply).
- ▶ The License Authorization Wizard sends your authorization code over the internet to SPSS Inc. and automatically retrieves and verifies your site license. If your computer is behind a proxy, click Configure proxy settings and enter the appropriate settings. Select Next.
- ▶ The final window will appear, showing that the licensing has been completed. Select Finish and you are now ready to use the SPSS product or products that you have successfully licensed.

**Note:** If the authorization process fails, you will be prompted to send an e-mail message. Choose whether you want to send the e-mail message through your desktop e-mail system or through a Web-based e-mail application.

- If you choose the desktop option, a new message with the appropriate information will be created automatically.
- If you choose the Web-based option, you must first create a new message in your Web-based e-mail program. Then copy the message text from the License Authorization Wizard and paste it into your e-mail application.

Send the e-mail message and respond to the prompt in the License Authorization Wizard. The e-mail message will be processed almost instantaneously. You can select Enter License Code(s) to enter any license code(s) that you receive. If you have already closed the License Authorization Wizard, restart it and select License my product now. On the Enter Codes panel, add the license code that you received and select Next to complete the process.
